The **University of the Philippines Open University (UPOU)** invites all Farmers and Fisherfolk Enterprise to participate in the NEGOTIATION for the Procurement of the **UPOU-NP-SS-2026-003, Supply and Delivery of Rice (Second Tranche of Rice Subsidy for FY2026)**, with the following specifications:

Locally harvested **Dinorado/Jasmine or its equivalent, moisture content: 12-14.5%; 80/20 ratio of whole vs. broken grains**, harvested from March 2026 to May 2026, well-milled, no blending with other varieties, without any non-rice element (per actual sample kept at SPMO); no impurities; no foul order; soft, tasty and edible even five hours after cooking. Random rice samples for testing (two levels) shall be selected by the UPOU BAC. Penalty for non-compliance: PhP1,562.50 for every sack.

Packaging:

Sealed in thick blue or yellow plastic sack, with transparent lateral sides printed with supplier's name, weight, type of rice, date milled; **minimum of 60kgs/bundle of rice (packed into 2 separate sacks), equivalent to PhP3,125.00.**

Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC): **Two Hundred Twenty-Eight Thousand One Hundred Twenty-Five Pesos (Php 228,125.00).**

Delivery of the Goods is required within 7-15CD from receipt on the Purchase Order and Notice to Proceed and to be delivered at the 1) **University of the Philippines Open University, UPOU Headquarters, Los Baños, Laguna** and, 2) **UPOU Diliman Office, Quezon City**, from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm, Monday to Friday.

Interested Farmers and Fisherfolk Enterprise must submit requirements for accreditation in order to participate in the negotiation for the said procurement.

Deadline for submission of documentary requirements and offer is on or before **12:00 PM, June 23, 2026** at **UP Open University, Supply and Property Management Office, Los Baños, Laguna, 4031.**

REQUIREMENTS FOR ACCREDITATION

I. Eligibility Criteria

- a) Must be registered in the FFEDIS. However, the submission of any of the following accreditation or registration documents, as the case may be, shall likewise be allowed and deemed compliant with the FFEDIS registration, unless otherwise provided in the applicable issuance of DA:
 - i) Accreditation as Civil Society Organization (CSO);
 - ii) Registration in the Registry System for Basic Sector in Agriculture (RSBSA);
 - iii) Registration in the Fishery Registry (FishR) System;
 - iv) Registration in the National Coconut Farmers Registry System (NCFRS); or
 - v) Registration or accreditation in any other DA-approved registry or accreditation system.
- b) Must have the necessary capacity to timely deliver the agricultural and fishery products required under the Procurement Project in accordance with the specifications, quality standards, and quantities determined by the PE.
